The Robins Chiefs Group Academic Scholarship (Continuing Education)

Since its inception, the Robins Chiefs Group has been dedicated to helping deserving individuals achieve their educational goals through its scholarship program. The Robins Chiefs Group Academic Scholarship (Continuing Education) recognizes adult learners who have maintained an outstanding scholastic record while pursuing higher education, as well as participation in school and community activities. Recipients will receive at least \$500. Up to four scholarships are awarded annually.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1. An applicant must be an enlisted military member (Active Duty, Reserve, National Guard or retired), or the dependent of an enlisted military member (Active Duty, Reserve, National Guard, retired, or deceased) assigned to or retired from Robins Air Force Base. Any enlisted rank or branch of service is eligible. In the case of retired or deceased sponsors, the applicant must have remained in the Robins AFB area. Proof of dependent status is required.
- 2. An applicant must be currently attending an accredited institution of higher learning (university, college, technical college, etc) on a full-time basis. An applicant must also be enrolled as a full-time student at that institution by Fall 2025.
- 3. Previous recipients of **The Robins Chiefs Group Academic Scholarship (High School)** are <u>eligible</u> to apply for this award. All other previous Robins Chiefs Group Scholarship recipients are <u>ineligible</u>. Applicants who possess a military academy appointment, ROTC scholarship, or any other full four-year scholarship that includes room and board are <u>ineligible</u> for these scholarships. Also <u>ineligible</u> are dependents who receive full tuition payment under coverage provided by the Post-9/11 GI Bill.

PROCEDURE:

A selection panel composed of members of the Robins Chiefs Group will determine the award recipients based on <u>scholastic achievement</u> (grade point average (GPA) based on 4.0 scale and academic honors), <u>involvement in school</u> (student government, tutoring, mentoring, clubs, etc), and <u>involvement in the community</u> (volunteer activities, service organizations, church, etc). Applicants will also complete a short personal statement outlining their educational goals. Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection no later than June 2025.

The applicant must provide all of the following:

- 1. Completed application signed in the appropriate places.
- 2. Proof of status of military member and dependent.
- 3. An official transcript in a sealed envelope from the school currently attending.
- 4. Typed listing of the following accomplishments and activities engaged in while pursuing higher education, divided and titled by category:
 - a. Scholastic achievement (GPA based on 4.0 scale and academic honors or distinction)
 - b. Involvement in school (student government, tutoring, mentoring, clubs, etc)
 - c. Involvement in community (volunteer activities, service organizations, church, etc)
 - 5. Typed personal statement of no more than 500 words outlining the applicant's educational goals.

The entire application package containing all required documents and forms must be mailed, **postmarked no later than June 1, 2025**, to the following address:

Note: The award <u>must</u> be used within the <u>2025–2026 academic year</u> for educational use billed by the institution (tuition, fees, on-campus room and board, etc). <u>The award money is mailed directly to the recipient's school upon written verification of the recipient's full-time status.</u> It is the award recipient's responsibility that the RCG's scholarship committee receives this verification <u>postmarked no later than October 1, 2025</u> before any money is paid. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the award.
